White Haven MEMORIAL PARK



All Mowed Areas of the Park

- Fresh or Silk Flowers may be placed in a White Haven installed vase cup from March 15th thru November 5th.
- Flags may also be placed in White Haven installed vase cups from March 15th thru November 5th. On Veterans Day ONLY, flags may be placed directly in the ground. (They will be removed the following day.)
- Green, winter wreaths can be no larger than 24" in diameter on a tripod stand (not stakes) and may be used from November 15th thru March 15th. (Wreaths are not permitted in Jewish Sections V and T)

Nature Trails and Green Burial Areas

- Fresh flower stems only
- No artificial flowers of any type
- No plastic, cellophane, wire or rubber bands
- No containers of any type
- No pebbles, rocks, picture frames, toys, crosses, hats, candles, etc.
- No wreaths
- No potted plants

THESE RULES APPLY AT ALL
TIMES THROUGHOUT THE YEAR

Mausoleum Crypts and Niches

- Bronze vases with silk flowers purchased from and installed by White Haven are permitted year round on interior and exterior crypts and niches.
- Exterior crypts that have vase cups may be filled with fresh/silk flowers or greens.
- No wreaths or other decorations should be placed in the area.

Items that are NOT permitted in the Park

- Balloons
- Pinwheels
- Toys
- Frames
- Glass of any type
- Stuffed animals
- Wind chimes
- Photos or Pictures
- Cards
- Stones, pebbles or shells left on or around the marker
- Coins
- Food or candy of any type

Even though they are very meaningful to you, they take away from the natural beauty of the Park. They may also cause damage to the environment, the bronze marker, our equipment and/or the crypt or niche front.

All non-permissible decorations will be removed by White Haven personnel and taken to our Maintenance Building, where they will be sorted by Section or Mausoleum and remain available for pick-up for approximately one month from date of removal.
