OFFICE AND MAUSOLEUM HOURS

For the office....the office is open from Monday—Friday 9:00 am—5:00 pm, Saturday 9:00 am—12:00 pm and closed Sunday. Our lobby is open and we are only allowing 2 people in the lobby at a time. We are requesting that you wear a mask and use the hand sanitizer in the vestibule before you enter the building. If you would like to call ahead we can email you maps for a gravesite location. For a marker appointment or property, please call the office ahead of time to schedule an appointment. Please be patient as we are trying to keep all of our families and staff safe.

For the mausoleums....they are open every day from 9:00 am—3:00 pm. For the safety of everyone visiting and our staff, we have removed most of the furniture. Please wear masks and maintain social distancing while visiting.

🗞 FLOWERS AND DEDICATIONS 🖗

Spring is right around the corner! After March 15th, please feel free to begin placing flowers in your loved one's in-ground vase. If you do not already have an in-ground vase and would like one, please call the office to order one for just \$45. We also have complimentary temporary vases located in a bin by the back door of the office. Unfortunately, if your loved one is located in the Green Burial Section, Nature Trail, our Lakeview Cemetery, and other areas of the park which are not designated for vases, you will not be eligible for a vase. When deciding to come out, please keep in mind that the water will not be turned on until May 1st to prevent freezing pipes, so you will need to supply your own. We also ask that you call the office ahead of time so that we may have one of our grounds crew raise the vase. Please do not attempt to raise the vase yourself as it may get stuck and damaged, resulting in additional fees to you in order to replace it. If you have any questions, please feel free to call the office at 585-586-5250.

FLOWERS...Would you like a silk bouquet to be placed in your loved one's in-ground vase for the Spring

and Fall? White Haven offers bouquets every year to anyone who has a permanent vase. The bouquets vary in style from year to year, but they are always composed of beautiful and brightly colored seasonal flowers. Each bouquet is \$25 and if you need to purchase a vase, it would be an additional \$45. If you are interested and would like to order one or both of the bouquets, please call the office at 585-586-5250 to ensure your loved one is eligible for this service.



DEDICATIONS...Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, and Father's Day are all wonderful times to dedicate one of our silk flower arrangements placed on the tables in the mausoleums to your loved one. Your loved one's name will appear in a list on a plaque next to the various large flower arrangements throughout the mausoleums. The dedications will remain up for 2 weeks and are \$20 each. If you have ordered the Spring dedications within the past 2 years, please be on the lookout for the 2021 form in your mail around the end of February.
