PRESERVATION FOUNDATION

The Preservation Foundation was established in 2013 as a charitable organization to help the cemetery maintain and preserve historic structures, wildlife and the indigenous trees that adorn the Park. Since 2013, your donations have helped preserve and create many changes in the Park such as, repair our beautiful fountain, the creation of nature trails in the back of the Park, replaced the fence along Marsh Road, installed a new flag pole to honor our Veterans, purchase a tree mapping system that helps us track all of the trees in the Park, create a monarch weigh station, build habitats for blue birds and owls. These are just a few of the upgrades your donations have allowed us to complete.

To continue our efforts to preserve the Park, we are asking for your support. Since no goods or services would be given in the exchange for your donation it is deductible to the fullest extent, allowed by law. FLOWERS AND DEDICATIONS

Spring is right around the corner! After March 15th, feel free to begin placing flowers in your loved one's in-ground vase. If you do not already have an in-ground vase and would like one, call the office to order one for just \$45. We also have complimentary temporary vases located in a bin by the back door of the office. Unfortunately, if your loved one is located in the Green Burial Section, Nature Trail, our Lakeview Cemetery, and other areas of the park which are not designated for vases, you will not be eligible for a vase. When deciding to come out, keep in mind that the water will not be turned on until May 1st to prevent freezing pipes, so you will need to supply your own. If you are having trouble raising the vase, please call the office and we will arrange for a work order to be generated. Do not attempt to raise the vase yourself as it may get stuck and damaged, resulting in additional fees to you in order to replace it. FLOWERS... Unfortunately, unless you have already placed an order for Spring flowers we are sold out and cannot get anymore from our vendors. You are more than welcome to place your own but make sure they are labeled with your loved ones name and location. Please call the office at 585-586-5250 if you have any questions.



DEDICATIONS... Easter, Mother's Day, Memorial Day, and Father's Day are all wonderful times to dedicate one of our silk flower arrangements placed on the tables in the mausoleums to your loved one. Your loved one's name will appear in a list on a plaque next to the various large flower arrangements throughout the mausoleums. The dedications will remain up for 2 weeks and are \$20 each.
